**New World Language State Standards: Designing Articulated Assessment Transfer Tasks**

Our NYS World Language Standards are under revision. Jennifer Eddy will explain these shifts and guide us on performance assessment in the three modes of communication. Articulation is intentional curriculum design for language performance and proficiency goals between levels, buildings and schools. Articulated Assessment Transfer Tasks (AATs) are designed for learners to engage critical thinking skills, intercultural competence, and solve problems and create products of value beyond the classroom across three target levels of learner engagement. Teachers are encouraged to design an exemplar for alignment with upcoming revised WL standards in NYS.
